MEMBERSHIP VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT:

The Palmetto Skate Club is an organization led by dedicated individuals who volunteer their time to provide a figure skating club based on fun, good sportsmanship and friendships. We cannot continue to offer the activities we do without the contributions of time, talent, resources and experience of our volunteers. We depend on volunteers to be successful! As you can see below, it takes a lot of people working behind the scenes to have a successful program. But the more people we have to help, the less work each individual has to do!

EACH family has an obligation to volunteer their service in order for the club to run efficiently. Please check the committees that you will serve on:

- Fundraising Committee** – The club should do at least two major fundraisers per year that all members participate in. Other fundraisers geared toward a specific purpose (such as out of town competitions, etc.) are also important. This committee should also investigate and apply for qualified grants as well as business and corporate sponsorship. This is one of the most important committees we have.
- Hospitality Committee** – For our competitions and test sessions, a hospitality room has to be set up for judges and coaches. Planning a menu and getting food donations from club members (and even area businesses) are the duties of this committee.
- Communications/Marketing Committee** – A club newsletter needs to be re-instituted (either monthly or every other month). Also, weekly email updates need to be sent to club members to keep them informed of important information. Also, announcements about our competitions, shows, and successes of our club and its members needs to be sent out to local media.
- Competition Committee** – The skate club hosts two competitions per year: the Jessamine Open in March (USFS) and the Palmetto Classic in October (ISI). Areas of the competitions that need people to lead are: sanctions, entry forms and fee payment, scheduling, awards, ice monitoring, music and announcing, goody bags, skater check-in, set up and tear down, and skate club table sales.
- Membership Committee** – This committee maintains all membership records and communicates with the club Vice Presidents of USFS and ISI for enrollment in those two organizations. Membership forms should be readily available at all times. A membership drive should be organized before the end of each membership year.
- Show committee** – The club has two skate shows per year: the Spring show in May and the holiday show in December. Areas that need people to lead are: sanctions, themes, entry forms and fee payment, scheduling, end of the year awards (Christmas show only), graduating seniors (Spring show only), ice monitoring, music and announcing, skater check-in, decorations, set up and tear down, and skate club table sales.
- Clothing and Consignment Committee** – This committee is in charge of club clothing orders, consignment dresses (processing what comes in as well as sales), and rental costumes.
- Freestyle Committee** – This committee should volunteer and recruit volunteers to work freestyle sessions, both collecting money and punching cards as well as running music. A master calendar should be kept with which volunteers are working what sessions.
