



RULES

1. All skaters must check in and/or pay (if walk-on) at the PSC table before going on the ice. Only skaters who have paid are allowed on the ice.
2. Freestyle sessions are for lessons and practicing, not for socializing.
3. Any skater who has not paid will be asked to leave the ice; skaters who repeatedly skate without paying may have their skating privileges revoked.
4. Skaters may be on the ice only during the time for which they have paid.
5. 5:15-6:00 is reserved only for FS1 and higher. No lower level skaters may be on the ice during this time, unless in a lesson supervised by a coach.
6. There will be no refunds for lost or stolen passes. PSC keeps a record of cardholders and will honor the freestyle sessions, but skaters will not be able to redeem public sessions of lost cards.
7. Eating, drinking, or chewing gum on the ice is not allowed.
8. Respect professionals, parents, employees, and other skaters.
9. Do not interrupt lessons.
10. Skaters in a lesson have 1st right of way.
11. Skaters in a program have 2nd right of way.
12. All skaters must wear freestyle vest during his/her program.
13. Right of way or not, skaters of a higher level have the responsibility to skate with caution when lower level skaters are present.
14. Proper skating attire is required for all freestyle sessions.
15. Music:
 - a) There are two lines for music to be played, one for coaches in a lesson and one for skaters not in a lesson. Coach's line has 1st priority, but will alternate with skater's line when necessary.
 - b) Skaters out of a lesson have 2nd priority.
 - c) As long as there is music in line, music cannot be restarted or rewind.
 - d) Music is to be played only by PSC members/coaches who have been trained by PLEX.

Any skater in violation of these rules and guidelines may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including permanent expulsion from freestyle sessions.
